ABOUT THE PROJECT

The SENSES project will support enterprise and entrepreneurship education, by providing teachers within primary education with an understanding of social entrepreneurship and social innovation and access to a set of innovative tools which can be used to enhance skills in teaching SEI.

In addition, the project will support learners aged between 7-12 in developing a set of structured competences required to be enterprising and entrepreneurial in a social context. These competences will include adaptability, solving complex and 'wicked' problems and creativity and innovation.

1. CAPACITY BUILDING FOR SENSES TEACHERS: A COMPLETED PACKAGE



The IO1 - Capacity building for SENSES teachers will be a targeted, completed approach developing amongst the teachers at primary education, with knowledge, skills, guidelines and proper methodology for Social Entrepreneurship and Innovation (SEI) in the classroom.

This IO was designed in order to give the teachers the ways of how to provide their students with the skills and knowledge they need to succeed in the 21st century and to prepare to solve (or at least) to respond to the societal challenges and the world's most urgent problems; equipping teachers is the channel of equipping students to become 'pathfinders' to systemic solutions.

Our main principle is to invest in teachers' understanding and knowledge of SEI, thus, this will be the way of maximizing the number of children understanding and being immersed in the 'world' of social entrepreneurship and innovation.

Our set of learning materials and resources for teachers will be uploaded shortly on our SENSES platform and it will include la knowledge base reviewing current thinking a practices, lesson plans, learning activities and assessment tests.

The second SENSES partner meeting was held in Eurotraining's premises in Athens, Greece on the 11th and 12th of November. During the second day of the meeting, the dissemination of the project was discussed as well as guidelines for the financial administration and project management were provided. The quality assurance and evaluation activity was reviewed which highlighted the scope of the internal and external quality measures.
